

Centre in Saskatoon, Oct 1-4, 2023.



The economy of Canada, and indeed of much of North America relies significantly on our natural resources, including the agriculture, mining, forestry and energy sectors, all of which are significant in the Province of Saskatchewan. Development of these industries, as well as getting goods to market is dependent upon reliable safe and effective infrastructure, roads, earthworks etc.

Design and construction of all these requires us to meet great challenges requiring geotechnical, geosynthetics and hydrogeological expertise. Being held in the "City of Bridges" in the beautiful valley of the South Saskatchewan River, the theme of the conference is "bridging". Bridging research & practice, bridging theory & experience, and above all, bridging different areas of practice. Geotechnical practice is often characterised as being distinct in the separate sectors of Infrastructure and Resources, however so many lessons can be learned, and experiences shared when we focus on the similarities, differences, and synergies in different areas of geotechnical, geosynthetics and hydrogeological practice.

This conference will highlight both theoretical and practical advances in the broad fields of geotechnics, highlighting the ways in which challenges have been met in both the Infrastructure and Resources sectors. The technical program will be enhanced by the inclusion of several distinguished international keynote speakers. Sessions will encompass a wide range of topics of regional, national and international relevance. In addition to the technical program, high quality short courses and technical tours will be offered. The technical program will be supplemented by an extensive social program including the Opening Icebreaker, Exhibitor Reception, Awards Banquet and Local Colour Night.



# GeoSaskatoon 2023

#### **LOCATION**

Saskatoon is located within the Traditional Territory of Treaty 6 First Nations and the Homeland of the Metis. Saskatoon was listed on The New York Times list of 52 Places to Go in 2018 a highly regarded international ranking of cities, regions, and countries that travelers should explore. Placed #18 on the list, Saskatoon was the only Canadian destination. Saskatoon's newly renovated and award-winning international airport provides direct or one-stop service to over 240 global destinations, making the trip easy for people arriving from across the country and internationally. With a walkable downtown, and only 15 minutes from the airport, delegates can experience the many eateries and shops in convenient locations. Explore the trails and beaches of Beaver Creek and Cranberry Flats, hike the Meewasin Valley Trail, visit the city's many galleries and museums, and shop at the Midtown Plaza (attached to the TCU Conference Centre). #### **VENUE**

Located in downtown Saskatoon, TCU Place – Saskatoon's Arts and Convention Centre is considered to be one of the best conference facilities in Western Canada. Convention space features a flexible wall system, dedicated registration area, and state-of-the-art built-in audio/visual equipment. Features include 19-foot ceilings, wall-to-wall carpet, and a wall of natural light creating the perfect ambience.
